Reporting to the Manager of Field Services, successful candidates will be involved in field and laboratory testing of soil, aggregate, concrete, mortar and bituminous paving mixture. Candidates will be required to work independently, observe and report abnormalities and verify procedures. Accurate data entry will be required. Successful candidates will review, analyze and interpret test results, recognize errors and non confirming results and take remedial action in consultation with the Manager/Supervisor. Initiating and implementing process improvement will also be encouraged. All training programs will be provided as part of orientation and will be compensated by the Company. Work boots are mandatory – all other Personal Protective Equipment will be provided.

Successful candidates must have graduated from a related post secondary program OR have a minimum of 5 years experience in the testing of concrete, aggregate, soils and asphalt by performing routine and complex testing procedures. A valid "G" driver's licence and a good driving record are required. The position involves lifting heavy samples up to approximately 25 kg and the ability to work in various weather conditions. Out of town work and weekend work will be required. All overtime will be paid in accordance with Ontario legislation. All travel expenses will be covered by the Company. Applicants must be familiar with Occupational Health & Safety regulations and policies. A working knowledge of computerized test reporting in Word, Excel and Word Perfect would also be a definite asset.
