## NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

### Carrick-Vickers Multi-Use Bridge Over the McIntyre Floodway

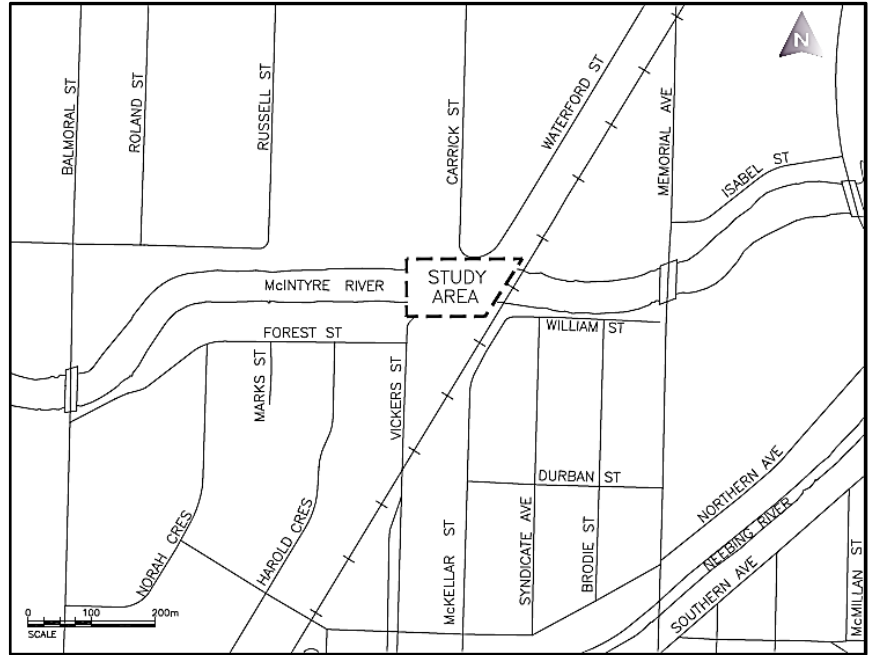
TBT Engineering Limited (TBTE), on behalf of the City of Thunder Bay (COTB), is proposing the design of a multi-use pedestrian bridge over the McIntyre Floodway to establish a north-south cycling corridor as part of the City of Thunder Bay Active Transportation Plan. This project will connect Vickers Street on the south side of the river, to Carrick Street on the north side of the river.

This project is being planned under **Schedule B** of the **Municipal Class Environmental Assessment**. Subject to any comments received as a result of this Notice, and the receipt of necessary approvals, The City of Thunder Bay intends to proceed with the design, tendering, and construction of this project during the 2019 construction season.

If there are no requests received by March 11, 2019, the City of Thunder Bay intends to proceed with the design and construction of this project.
